FROM OUR COORDINATOR **EMERITUS:** As I sit down to put down my thoughts as Riverbend TEC Coordinator, this time is different. I have been the Coordinator for 36 years and I consider it a great blessing in my life as a priest. It has been a lot of work behind the scenes but it has been worth it. Over these years Riverbend TEC has had some struggles and also great successes. In the 265 TEC weekends scheduled since April 1977 we have had 10,823 team members sharing their time, faith, and service. There have been 7,718 Tecites who have grown in their encounter with Christ. These are impressive numbers but the most important part of these years is the opportunity for team and Tecites to grow spiritually and in their encounter with Christ. I have grown spiritually and I thank the bishops of the Diocese of New Ulm, from Bishop Lucker through Bishop LeVoir, for their support for Riverbend TEC and of me as the Coordinator and Spiritual Director for Riverbend TEC. There are many I need to thank especially the host parishes where TEC has been held and those who have served on the TEC Council and in leadership on TEC weekends. The strength of Riverbend TEC is in all those who have been involved in TEC. It is inspiring to see so many youth and adults who have been

part of TEC involved in parishes living and sharing their faith.

This past fall as we discussed my "retirement" as Coordinator for Riverbend TEC it seemed wise to have a set date for new people to take over and for me to move into the background. We decided on June 30, 2017 as the effective date for my resignation. In order for there to be a smooth transition I will work closely with the new coordinator and spiritual director.

Through a thorough discernment process and input from many Tecites involved in Riverbend TEC we have come up with a great leadership team. Katie Prokosch will be the Coordinator, Justin Prokosch, her husband, will be the assistant Coordinator. Fr. Tony Hesse will be the Spiritual Director and Fr. Andy Michels will be the assistant Spiritual Director. They take over leadership for Riverbend TEC on July 1, 2017. I look forward to working closely with them. I ask everyone to keep Riverbend TEC and its new leadership in your prayers. I look forward to continued involvement on TEC weekends and with leadership as needed.
